

The 1st China-ASEAN Dam Science Popularization Contest

Attentions:

- The working language of this contest is English.
- Applicants who are currently in China will be invited to Nanjing to deliver their presentations.
 Applicants overseas are required to give their presentations online. There is no registration fee or any other payment for participating in this contest.
- Participants should give a specific set context when elaborating a case in their presentations.
- Participants should complete the whole presentations independently.
- Participants should make and offer a PowerPoint with an aspect ratio of 16:9 (widescreen) to support their presentations.

Participants will give presentations on dam science. Topics can be related to dam policies; the planning, design, construction and management of dams; the formulation and application of technical standards and regulations about dams; dam science; the performance of a specific dam in flood control, water storage, water supply, power generation, shipping and environmental protection; the impacts of dams on social and economic development; international cooperation in the field of dams; and other relevant issues.

Presentations should last around 5-8 minutes in the form of a lecture. More than 10 judges from China, ASEAN Member Countries and International Organizations will review the presentations. The judging criteria of a presentation include three aspects: the content of the presentation, the impression of the presentation, and the overall image of the participant. The content should be accurate and clear, with logic in its hierarchy. The presentation is expected to be impressive by adopting good language pronunciation and simple syntax. The overall image of a participant should be well-dressed and energetic. Judges are also required to evaluate the timeliness of the content of one's presentation; thus, participants are encouraged to have their topics on up-to-date technologies in hydro science.

The contest will set up first prizes, second prizes, and third prizes. Besides, there are special prizes for excellent participants. These prizes all come with official certificates and awards.
