he first formal meeting of the International Commission on Large Dams was held in Paris on 6 July 1928, with representatives from six nations ICOLD is now comprised of 88 countries and 10,000 individual members. who have built up together nearly one century of knowledge.

Sustainable Development, **World Hunger, Climate** Change, most of the 21st century's challenges are leading to dams.

One of the fundamental requirements for socio-economic development throughout the world is the availability of adequate quantities of water with the appropriate quality and an adequate supply of energy. Hydropower is a renewable source of energy and supplies about 20% of the world's needs. Properly planned, designed, constructed and maintained dams contribute significantly toward fulfilling water supply and energy requirements. To accommodate the variations in the hydrologic cycle, which will increase with global climate change, dams and reservoirs are needed to store water and then provide a consistent discharge to maintain the required daily flow in our rivers throughout the year.
